

COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP

Point Awarded;

1 – County AGM – 2 points per member maximum of 16points

2 – 3 County Executive, Rally and Show meetings – 5 points per member up to a maximum of 15 points per meeting.

4– 8 helping at Rally, Lincs Show, County Jingle and Spring Balls – 5 points per member helping.

9- Yearbook 20 points per club report and an extra 10 points for any additional reports.

10 – Overseas visits and hosts 15points per hosting and visit

11 – Club Programme sent to County office before 7th Nov – 30 points

12 – 13 Training – 5 points per member attending 50 points for club

14 - Curve training included in programme 50 points per session for club (maximum of 100points)

15 – Club Accounts submitted to County Office Nov/ Jan/ club AGM - 50 points each time submitted maximum 120 points.

16 – Bonus points for promotion – 5 points each time the club promotes Young Farmers by attending outside events either to help with car parking or having a stand.

17 – 36 These are the County Competitions and points are awarded as follows for each competition:

1st – 25 points

2nd – 20 points

3rd – 15 points

4th – 10 points

Club entry and Participation – 5 points per team up to a maximum of 15 points

37 – Club of the Year. – The YFC Clubs are divided into three geographical areas.(North, South and Mid). Clubs in each area are visited by the area Liaison Officers and a member of the Management team who attend a business meeting and look at how the club is run. The top club in each area then go forward to compete for the club of the year.
