New Chair of Trustees for Kids Can Achieve

Kids Can Achieve (KCA), the Harrow Charity which supports children with special needs, is delighted to announce the appointment of a new Chair of Trustees, Carol Foyle. Carol was appointed unanimously as the new Chair at a meeting of the charity's trustees on May 11th.
